No. 83: GREEK COINS. KAMARINA. Tetradrachm, 425-405 BC. Toned, partial mintage, obverse slightly double-struck, very fine +. Estimate: 7,500 euros

No. 191: GREEK COINS. THRACIAN KINGS AND DYNASTS. Skostokos, 3rd century BC. Tetradrachm, ca. 290-280 BC. Well struck, light toning, extremely fine. Estimate: 3,000 euros

No. 282: GREEK COINS. KOINON OF EPIRUS. Didrachm. Ca. 234-168 BC. **Rare!** Some traces of horn silver, extremely fine. Estimate: 5,000 euros

No. 402: GREEK COINS. SAMOS. Tetradrachm. Ca. 400-366 BC. Peirandrides, magistrate. High relief, well struck, light toning, extremely fine. Estimate: 15,000 euros

No. 544: GREEK COINS. PHILISTIA (unknown mint). Obol. 5th/4th century BC. **Extremely rare! Gitler-Tal plate coin!** Slightly toned, extremely fine. Estimate: 2,000 euros

No. 866: ROMAN PROVINCIAL COINS. PERINTHUS. Gordian III, 238-244 AD. AE medallion. **Rare!** Dark green, red-spotted shiny patina, very fine +. Estimate: 1,500 euros

No. 1008: ROMAN PROVINCIAL COINS. DALDIS. Gordian III, 238-244 AD. AE medallion. **Very rare!** Dark green, partially red-spotted patina, very fine. Estimate: 5,000 euros

No. 1260: ROMAN REPUBLIC. C. Cassius Longinus and M. Servilius, 43-42 BC. Aureus. **Gold.** Extremely fine. Estimate: 30,000 euros

No. 1320: ROMAN IMPERIAL TIMES. Vespasian, 69-79 AD. Aureus. **Gold. Rare!** Fine to very fine. Estimate: 7,500 euros

No. 1397: ROMAN IMPERIAL TIMES. Septimius Severus, 193-211 AD. Aureus. **Gold! Very rare!** **Excellent portraits!** Extremely fine to FDC. Estimate: 30,000 euros

No. 2207: KEMPTEN, abbey. Anselm von Reichlin-Meldegg, 1728-1747. Ducat 1729. Gold. **Extremely rare.** Gem. Fine gold patina. Nearly FDC. Estimate: 15,000 euros

No. 2317: SCHLESWIG - HOLSTEIN - SCHAUBURG. Ernst III, 1601-1622. Broad double taler 1603, Altona. **Very rare, especially in this quality.** Gem. Beautiful patina. Extremely fine +. Estimate: 10,000 euros
