### **Numismatic Auctions at Gorny & Mosch in April – Highlights from Various Collections**

On 19 and 20 April, auction 276 “Coins of Antiquity” and auction 277 “Selected coins and medals from modern times” will be held by Gorny & Mosch in Munich. Two splendid print catalogues complement the auctions. Immediately following the public auctions, e-auction 278 will be held on 21 April.

#### **Auction 276**

765 ancient coins, weights and seals will be auctioned off on 19 April 2021 by auction house Gorny & Mosch in their premises in Munich. A special feature of this auction is the collection of the German ancient historian and epigrapher Peter Weiß, which was built up in the years between 1967 and 2015. The collection focuses on “Late Antiquity and Provincial Coinage” but also includes a considerable amount of seals and weights. An extremely rare pattern of emperor Hadrian, for instance, will be sold from this collection.

Pieces from the following collections are on offer:

- Greek and Roman coins from various collections
- special collection Kingdom of Bosphorus from German private ownership (part III)
- the Peter Weiß Collection

#### **Auction 277**

1130 selected coins and medals from modern times will be auctioned off on 20 April 2021 by auction house Gorny & Mosch in their business premises in Munich. The focus is on high quality pieces from the German States and the German Empire. At the end of the auction, 104 gold coins of other bidding increments will be on offer. Decadrachm  $\varnothing$  36mm (42.36g), approx. 405 - 400 BC. **Unsigned Work of Kimon.** High relief, obv. struck with a slightly worn die, very fine +/- almost extremely fine. With NGC tag ChXF, strike 4/5, surface 4/5. Estimate: 40,000 euros

No. 1048: BAVARIA. Charles Theodore, 1777 - 1799. Ducat 1780 ST, Munich. Isar gold ducat. **Gold**. RR! Almost FDC. Estimate: 15,000 euros

No. 1095: BRANDENBURG / PRUSSIA. John George, 1571 - 1598. Reichstaler 1587, Berlin. RR! Fine toning, extremely fine. Estimate: 10,000 euros
